Clothing

Please try and ensure your child is here as near as possible to the start of their session, 8:45 in the morning and 12:30 in the afternoon.

The group activity with their Key Person starts soon after their arrival time and it can be very distracting for the children to keep stopping to welcome late arrivals.

The group activity is an important part of your child's learning and is particularly important for their listening and attention skills. We understand that at times, things happen and you may be running late, if this is the case Mrs Hughes or Mrs Bradley will meet you in the entrance and take your child through to their group.
